

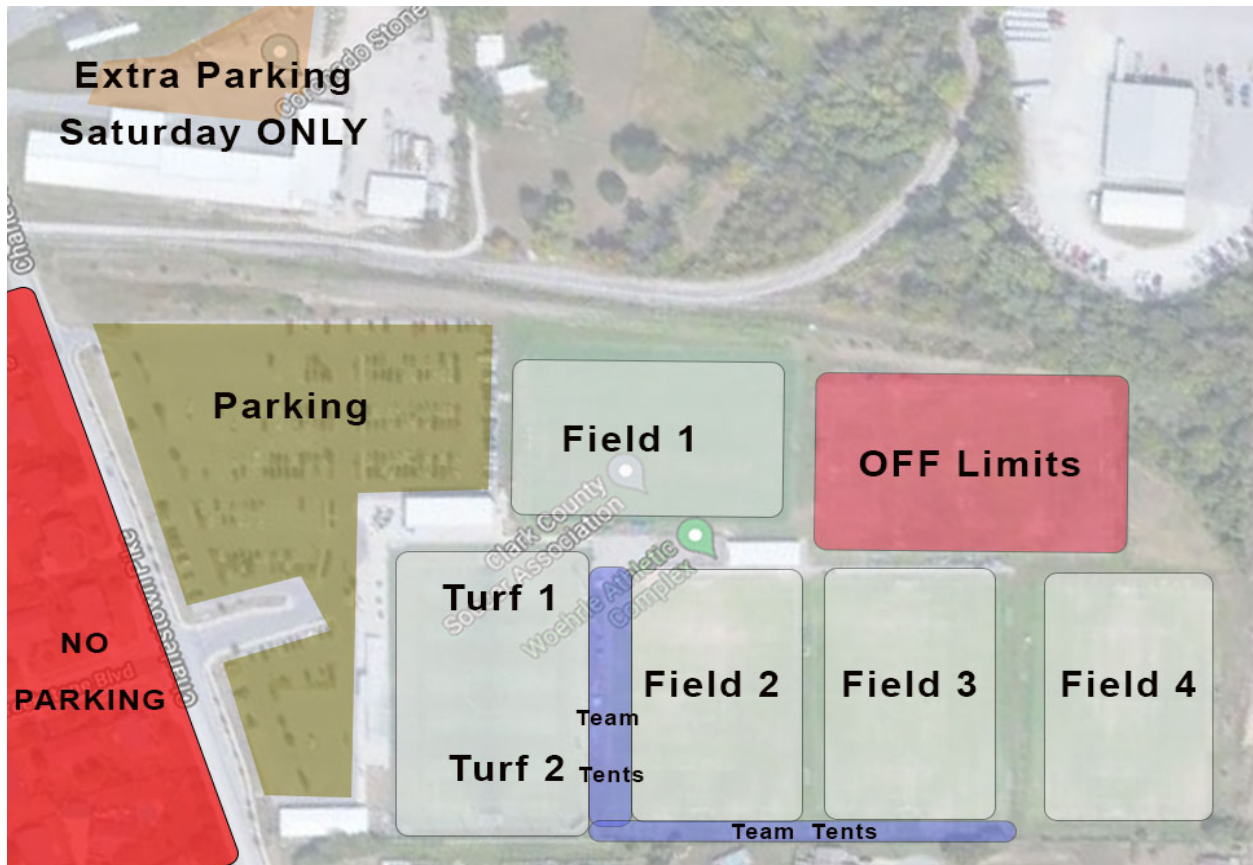
Indiana Homeschool State Soccer Association Families,

Welcome to the 2021 IHSSA Championship!

The championship is being hosted by the River City Jaguars, and will be played on the fields of Woehrle Athletic Complex this year. We wanted to get a letter out to all the families so that you know what to expect and for some house keeping items.

First off, the complex is smaller than many of the other locations the tournament has been held at in the past. On top of that, we anticipated being able to use the entire complex (five grass fields, and one turf) but the complex has limited our access by one field, due to a snafu in reseeding late summer. We sincerely apologize for the limited space we will have.

Team Tents

We know that some teams like to bring a couple of pop-ups and camp out underneath them with various food items. We have limited space for that, but are trying our best to get everyone comfortable. Please see the blue areas marked on the map. This will be along the black fence of the turf field and along the back edge of field 2 and field 3. Please try not to be directly behind the goals of field 2 and 3 to keep the referees happy. I do not believe there will be accessible power for crock-pots and the like in those areas.

Parking

Parking is limited, but should be sufficient. We're working on contingencies if we fill up. To that end, we cannot allow team RVs to set up camp in the parking lot. We apologize for that. The nearby Fairfield Inn has graciously allowed us to have overflow parking there. On Saturday the next door business is allowing us to use their parking lot for overflow. Please try to carpool from team hotels on Friday as much as possible. We'll be monitoring parking, and we may have to get a shuttle involved.
